Retake Policy:

Teachers will provide students the opportunity to be successful. In the event students fail to exhibit proficiency on the major assessments or tests, they will be encouraged to participate in the re-teaching/re-testing process.

Students will have the option of **CORRECTING A FALING GRADE** on an exam or students will have the option to **RE-TEST**. Students will receive their actual grade on any re-test, with the highest grade being a 70.

Students are encouraged to go to tutorials at any time. Students will be recommended to go to tutorials when grades fall below 75. Retakes of quizzes and daily work will be under the teacher's supervision.

Retakes of exams will be over the same material. Times and locations of exam retakes will be posted by Coach Coursey.

All retakes must be completed within one week of the assignment being returned.

Midterm or final exams are not to be included in the retake/retest policy.

Lab safety:

Safety is paramount in the lab. Students must always follow the directions of each lab and must not work on any part of the lab that has been excluded. During any drill, students must remain quiet and listen to any instructions given by the teacher. Students must report accidents to the teacher immediately.
