On Saturday November 11th, the Mansfield High School Class of 2018 will host Pumpkin Bash at Mansfield High School. As part of Pumpkin Bash, a local non-profit organization, Caring for Community, has agreed to come out and host a cornhole tournament where students can sign up in teams of two to play cornhole. Caring for Community is an IRS recognized 501 (c)3 organization with a mission to support our local community. At the cornhole tournament, Caring for Community will bring the boards, bags, and run the tournament, allowing the students to have a great time without worrying about the stress of running a successful tournament. Because it is a fundraiser, the Mansfield High School Class of 2018 will benefit from team registration fees for this tournament.

To give a little more insight on the Pumpkin Bash event, The MHS Class of 2018 hopes to start a new tradition both with Pumpkin Bash and the cornhole tournament where we offer a fun, family-friendly fall event, while supporting the Mansfield High School Senior Class. Senior year is a memorable yet expensive year for kids. For example, the MHS Class of 2018 will have both a senior field trip and a senior prom. What many people don't know is that at Mansfield High School, one in five students comes from an economically disadvantaged household. We want to ensure all of the MHS seniors, regardless of their household financial standing, have the opportunity to have an amazing senior year. Our goal is to have a senior field trip which is free for all students and a prom with affordable tickets. With enough money raised, we will be able to accomplish this and ensure a fun and memorable last year for all students.

Because Caring for Community is a non-profit organization, we are currently seeking sponsors as a way to support them and their efforts in helping the Mansfield community. To offer our support and show our gratitude to Caring for Community for helping us with our own fundraiser, we are currently seeking sponsors for the cornhole tournament to be lane sponsors. In the tournament, rounds will be played with two teams competing across from each other on different boards; these are called "lanes."
