

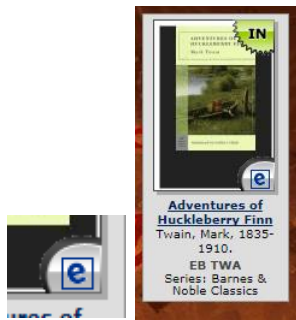
APPS:

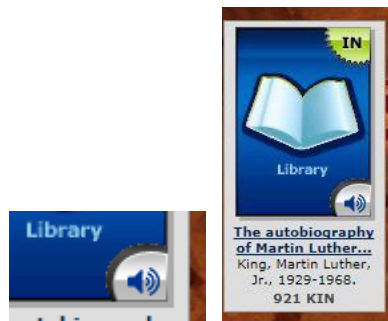

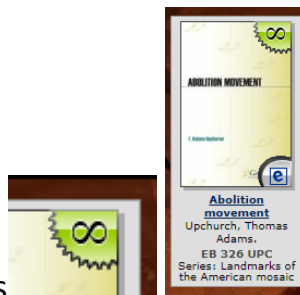
Ebook symbol

QUEST is unique and allows you, the user, to:

- change themes
- view book covers
- see the title availability and call number of search results
- limit search results to easily find what you need
- browse the scrolling carousel of bookshelves
- mouse over a title for more information
- drag and drop titles into *My List* and shelves
- see the top 10 circulated books
- showcase new title arrivals
- create book discussion threads between two friends using comments
